The Mission of Several Sources Shelters is to help shelter young, pregnant mothers and their babies, while providing education and ongoing compassionate support services. The Shelter also helps further educate young people to make healthy life choices. They also shelter women who are homeless, sick, elderly and help them restore their dignity.

Gimme Shelter is a movie that is appropriate for mature-minded middle school and high school teenagers. Since Gimme Shelter began in 2014, it has been seen in over 55 countries, including China, around the world and helped to bring many families with broken relationships back together with their children. Some teenagers have reported to Several Sources Shelters they have seen it as many as five times.

The healing qualities of Gimme Shelter affords you a great opportunity to discuss foster care, homelessness, teenage pregnancy and other important family issues.
